

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Follow all directions in your Zodi Shower Instruction Manual.
- 2. Connect threaded end of the Garden Hose Adapter to the end of a garden hose. Remove pump from Hot Tap^{TM} input hose and connect to the barbed end of the Garden Hose Adapter.
- 3. Slightly open the main water valve the garden hose is connected to. It is important to NOT fully turn "ON" the water source the garden hose is attached to. If the water pressure going into the Hot Tap™ is too high, it will cause the Garden Hose Adapter to disconnect from the Hot Tap™. Ensure water pressure is not too high in order to prevent unintentional separation.
- 4. After water sprays from the showerhead, ignite heater. Once the burner(s) are ignited, use the Hot Tap^{TM} gas valve to control the water temperature.
- 5. After showering, turn off burners and then turn off water at the main water valve.

NOTE

If Garden Hose becomes kinked, waterflow stops or decreases, or output water temperature increases, point showerhead away from body and turn heater off until proper water flow and temperature return.

CAUTION

- · Water must be flowing before igniting
- Do NOT heat indoors or in confined areas
- Do NOT transport with propane attached
- Do NOT pre-heat system
- Do NOT operate burner inside tent or RV
- · Do NOT leave system unattended when in use
- System is NOT designed to heat drinking water
- · Always test water temperature before use

Adjust water flow to 1 gallon in 2 minutes. Flows greater than this will not heat as hot.
